Golfers tee up £10,000 for charity

(Harpenden, Hertfordshire – February 25, 2008) Golfers at Aldwickbury Park Golf Club, Harpenden, celebrated a year of fundraising activities at a special charity awards evening on Thursday February 21.

A variety of fundraising events throughout the year – including a 50 pence donation for the 1,200 golf balls hit into the pond by the 18th green – resulted in £4,025 being raised for Grove House Hospice, the nominated charity of lady captain Pam Kershaw, and £4,025 for Sparks, which funds for medical research for children, nominated by men's captain Pat Hayward. A further £1,500 was raised for Great Ormond Street Hospital, London.

“There have been some outstanding charity events throughout the year including the men's and lady captains' days and evening social events,” said Aldwickbury Park Golf Club sales and marketing manager Simon Folbigg. “Golfers who hit their shots into the pond at the 18th have also given graciously and with 100 golf balls a month ending up in the water, a further £600 was raised.
